Seminar format:

Day one of the seminar focuses on performance foundations: building drive, retrieve and tug, plus food, hunt & pack (relationship) drives. Participants will gain an understanding of their dogs' drives and behavior, and how to use this information to more effectively play, motivate and train. **Day two** focuses on the end goals which include putting the pieces together, focus, stays, problem solving and trial routines. Day 2 is a continuation of the lecture from the first day, the discussion builds and is expanded across the two days. There is work-time for the working-spot dogs during both days.

A twenty-five year veteran of training, competing, and titling in schutzhund, obedience, tracking, agility, conformation, and herding who has earned multiple HITs in obedience and schutzhund.
